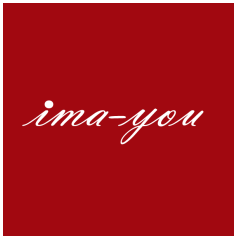

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About NIJO-Tea Ceremony Space



"Sen no Rikyū"

Perhaps the most well-known form of Japanese culture is the "chanoyu," or tea ceremony. The tea ceremony can be said to be the form that became mainstream today, led by "Sen no Rikyū" a merchant, cultural figure, and military commander, about 400 years ago. Although the tea ceremony was thought to be a purely Japanese culture, the latest research has found connections to Christianity, which was permeating Japan at the time.

A number of documents have been discovered at the Vatican that describe how the tea ceremony was utilized by Japanese missionaries of the time.

The boundaries of the tea ceremony that Rikyū reached are often expected to reflect the Japanese spiritual world, but it can be said to reflect the social conditions in Japan at the time, which were more global than expected.

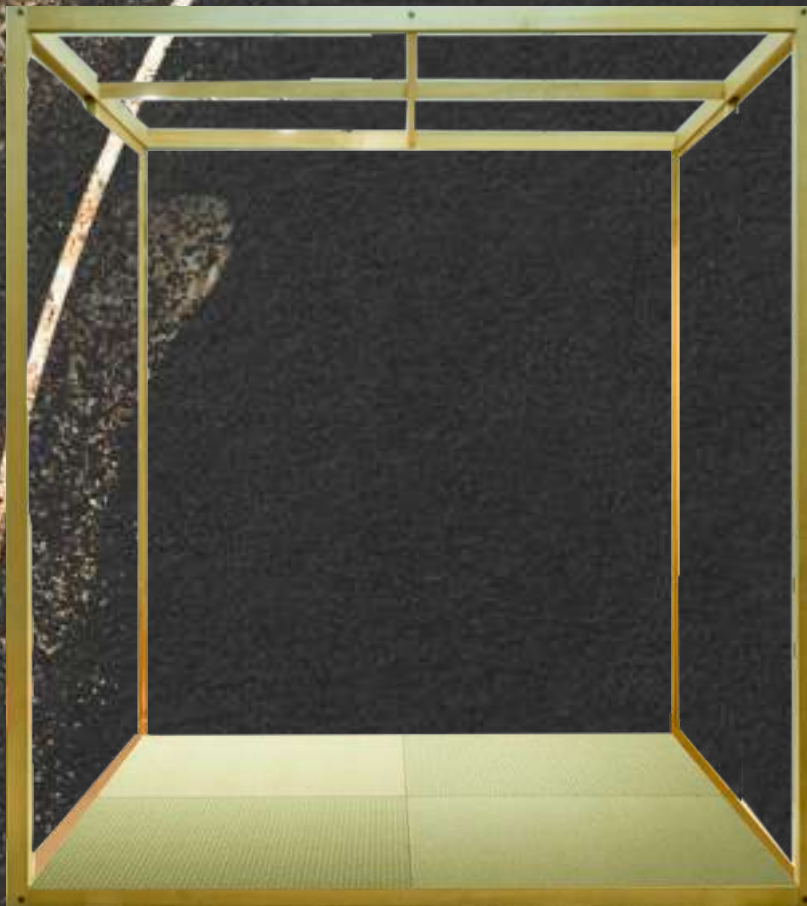

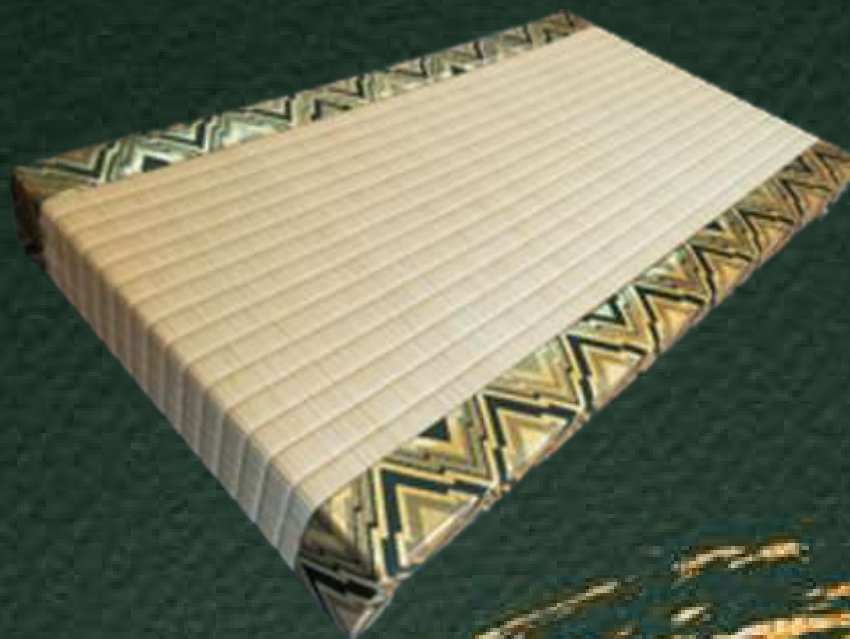

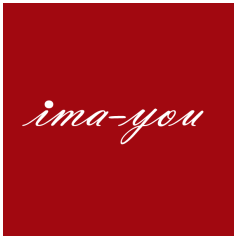
so it can be placed in a corner of a tatami room.
